

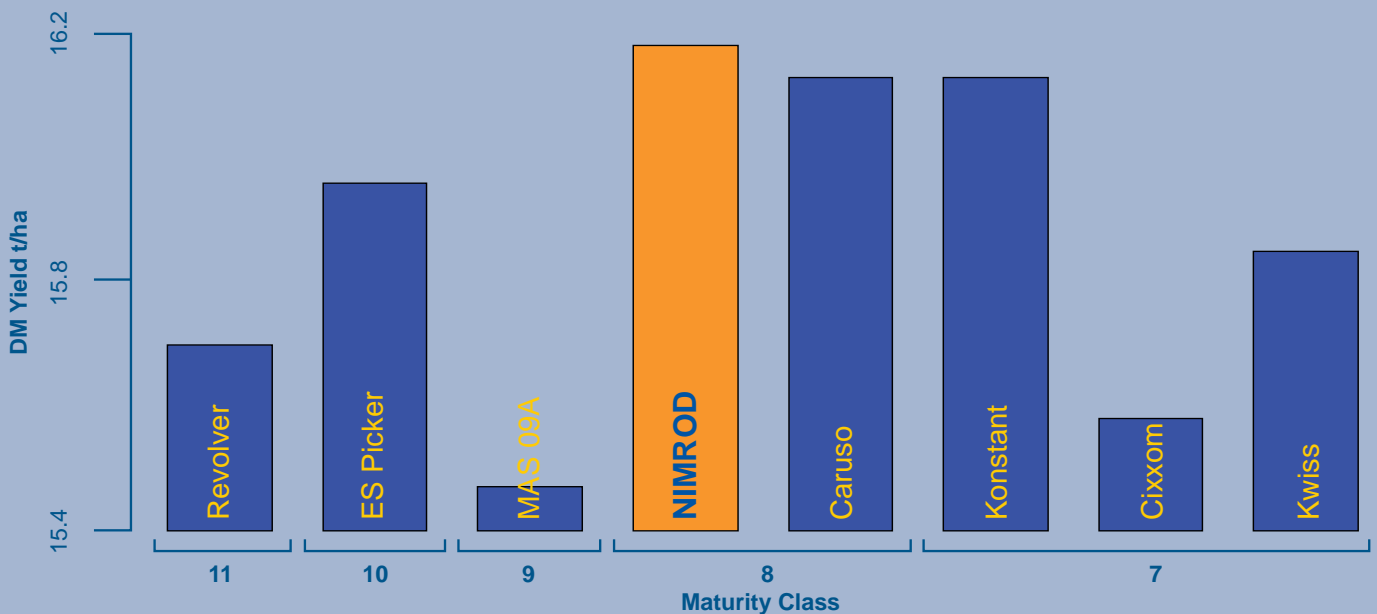


NIMROD

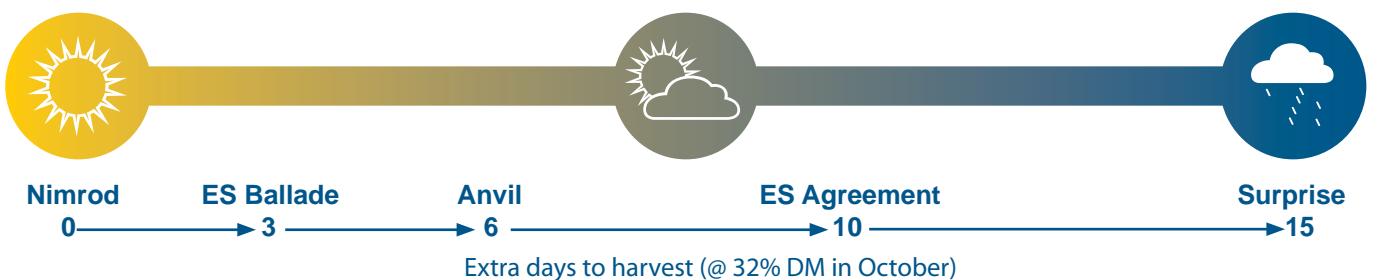
Nimrod is an excellent early maize variety bred by Advanta for use by British Dairy Farmers. It combines an early harvest with massive dry matter and high starch yields.

- Maturity Class 8 – early to harvest
- Massive dry matter yields – higher than most MC8 and all MC9+ varieties
- High starch yields – for good feed value
- Outyields MAS 09A and Cixxom – worth an extra £29+ per acre
- Higher starch yields than ES Agreement – worth an extra £28 per acre

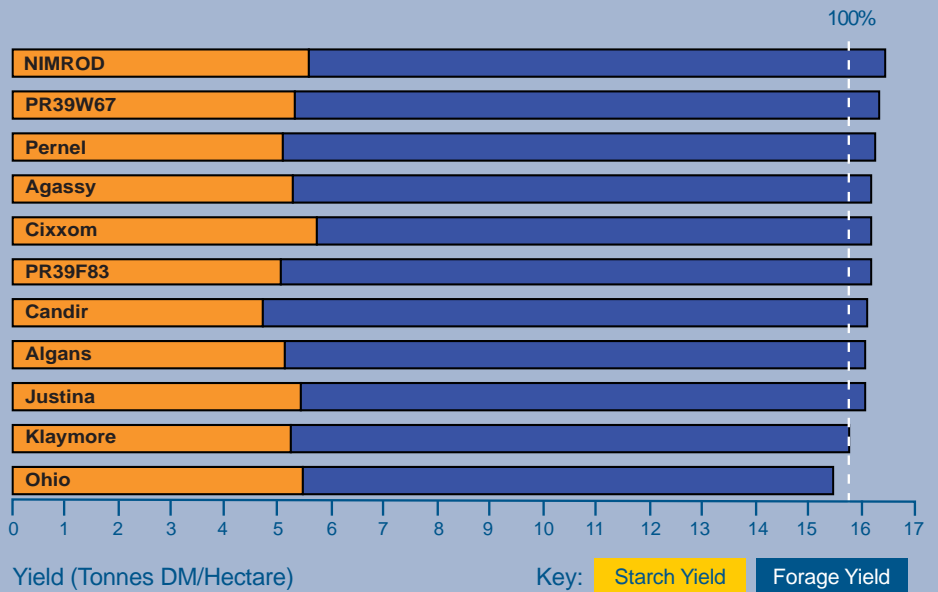

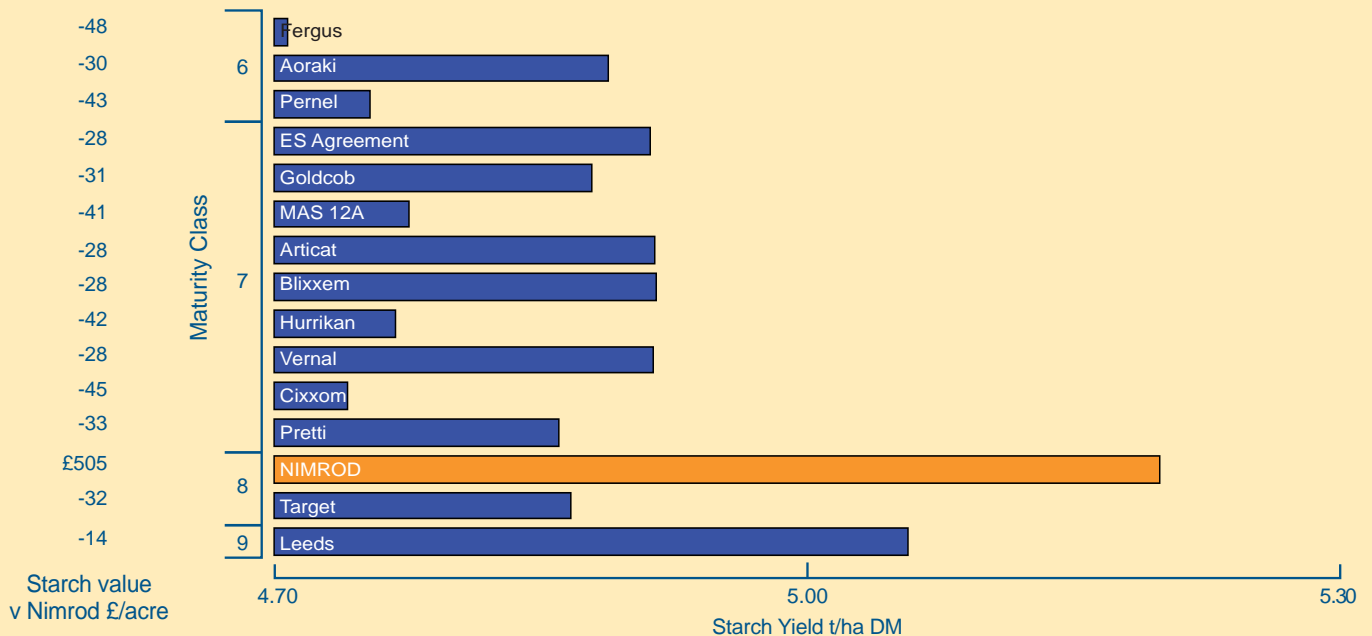

- Value Nimrod DM yield is £797 per acre

Starch Yield (NIAB Less Favourable Sites – 2008 List)



- Nimrod starch yield is worth £505 per acre.
- Starch valued at £240/t DM (based on winter wheat at £140 per tonne).
- Starch has been proven in independent CEDAR trials to be the single most important source of energy reported in ME figures for maize silage, meaning more efficient milk or meat production.
