



Ruler has very strong agronomic characters and is a stay green variety. The advantages of stay green are reduced field losses at harvest, longer harvest windows – very important if you're relying on a contractor to come, better consolidation in the clamp and reduced secondary fermentation. The result is more palatable silage which will increase voluntary feed intake.
